**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE, CALIFORNIA, REJECTING ALL BIDS, DISPENSING WITH COMPETITIVE BIDDING, AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS OR HIS DESIGNEE TO NEGOTIATE WITH ONE OR MORE BIDDERS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT IN AN AMOUNT “NOT-TO-EXCEED” \$15,550,000, AND APPROVING A 10% RESERVE CONTINGENCY IN THE AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED \$1,555,000, FOR THE LA CRESCENTA AVENUE REHABILITATION PROJECT, SPECIFICATION NO. 3829R, WITH A QUICK-BUILD DEMONSTRATION COMPONENT**

**WHEREAS**, on May 21, 2024, Council approved and adopted Specification No. 3829R for the La Crescenta Avenue Rehabilitation Project (“Project”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Public Works Department received 3 bids for the Project; and

**WHEREAS**, a detailed review of the bids revealed that all bids were non-responsive and did not meet the mandatory minimum qualifications with respect to contractor’s references and previously completed projects; and

**WHEREAS**, a detailed review of the bids revealed that all bids were non-responsive; and did not meet the mandatory minimum qualifications with respect to contractor’s references and previously completed projects, which required at least three different projects to be completed in the last five years as a prime contractor that have a minimum of three traffic signal improvements, a minimum total contract amount of \$5,000,000, work related to sewer improvements, and work related to street improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, Public Works Department staff believes a collaborative negotiation with one or more of the contractors that submitted bids would allow the contractor(s) to better understand the project requirements and eliminate excessive contingencies that the contractor(s) may have included in their initial submittal; and

**WHEREAS**, including a quick-build demonstration component in the negotiations will provide further opportunities for value engineering and partnering with the contractor; both of which will reduce the overall cost; and

**WHEREAS**, the Project currently has significant momentum due to the Public Works Department staff’s efforts and in order to maintain the progress of this project and funding, staff believes it is in the City’s best interest to negotiate with one or more of the contractors that submitted bids; and
