**AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE, CALIFORNIA  
AMENDING SECTIONS 2.04.080, 2.04.090, 2.04.120 AND 2.04.140 AND  
DELETING SECTION 2.04.150 OF THE GLENDALE MUNICIPAL CODE, 1995,  
PERTAINING TO THE ORDER OF BUSINESS, PROCEDURE AND DECORUM  
FOR COUNCIL MEETINGS**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE GLENDALE CITY:**

SECTION 1: Section 2.04.080 of the Glendale Municipal Code, 1995, entitled Order of Business, is hereby amended to read:

**“2.04.080 Order of Business.**

The Council shall establish the order of business for regular meetings of the Council by resolution.”

SECTION 2: Section 2.04.090 of the Glendale Municipal Code, 1995, entitled Right to address council, is hereby amended to read:

**“2.04.090 Right to address council**

The right of persons to submit written communications or address the council at council meetings on any matter concerning the city’s business shall be governed by the Ralph M. Brown Act, Government Code section 54950 *et seq.* and rules of order and procedure adopted by council resolution.”

SECTION 3: Section 2.04.120 of the Glendale Municipal Code, 1995, entitled Sergeant-at-arms – Ejection., is hereby amended to read:

**2.04.120 Sergeant-at-arms-Ejection**

The chief of police shall be ex officio sergeant-at-arms of the council. Any person in the audience who persistently delays or interrupts the proceedings of the council, refuses to keep quiet or sit down when ordered to do so by the presiding officer, or fails to comply with rules of order, procedure and decorum adopted by council resolution, may, upon order of the presiding officer, be ejected from the council chamber and kept out for the remainder of the meeting. The chief of police, or any police officer of the city present in the council chamber, shall carry out all orders given by the presiding officer with respect to such persons or for the purpose of maintaining order and decorum in the council chamber.

SECTION 4: Section 2.04.140 of the Glendale Municipal Code, 1995, entitled Governing Rules., is hereby amended to read:

**2.04.140 Governing rules**

In all matters and things not otherwise provided for in this chapter, the proceedings of the council shall be governed by council resolution adopting rules of order, procedure and decorum. In the event there are no adopted council rules of order, procedure and decorum, or said rules are silent on a matter of order, procedure or decorum, proceedings of the Council shall be governed by the latest revised edition of Robert's Rules of Order.

SECTION 5: Section 2.04.150 of the Glendale Municipal Code, 1995, entitled Motion to reconsider., is hereby deleted in its entirety.

SECTION 6: The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause the same to be published in accordance with law.
