

## Exhibit 2 – Table of Estimated Tariffs

The following table presents the estimated values of the primary tariffs. It DOES NOT include the value of the secondary tariffs on the importers of Venezuelan oil which would primarily impact China and to a lesser extent Italy and Canada.

Italy	20% reciprocal tariff, currently delayed	Wartsila GPRS Delivery occurred during the 90-day pause	
Mexico	25% tariff except USMCA	Electrical switchgear Transformers Delivery expected after the 90-day pause	\$1.7 million (ARB switchgear and transformers, split 50/50 between BOS and BESS) \$1.1 million (Wartsila switchgear)

Total ARB Wartsila tariffs considering the 90-day pause: \$0.2 million (0.2)

Total ARB BESS tariffs: \$22.85 million (22+0.85)

Total ARB BOS tariffs considering the 90-day pause: \$1.15 million (0.3+0.85)

Total Wartsila tariffs considering the 90-day pause: \$8.6 million (3.2+4.3+1.1)

<sup>1</sup> The tariff rules exempt materials that are covered by the U.S.-Mexico-Canada Agreement (USMCA) rules of origin. The equipment being supplied for the Grayson Repowering Project does not fall under these rules.
