

M O T I O N

Moved by Commissioner Kedikian, seconded by Commissioner Jazmadarian, that the Glendale Water and Power ("GWP") Commission having considered the presentation of Plan to Increase Solar Adoption and Develop Additional Distributed Energy Resources at the November 4, 2024 GWP Commission meeting, recommends that the Glendale City Council accept the findings of Energy Environmental Economics, Inc. (E3) in their final report and GWP's plan to increase solar adoption and develop additional distributed energy resources; including amending Resolution No. 22-125 as recommended by GWP staff to i) change the GWP customer solar adoption target of 10% by December 31, 2027 to 60 MW of solar generating capacity by 2030 to mitigate feasibility concerns and potential rate increases, ii) remove the target of achieving a minimum total peak dispatchable and peak-load-reducing capacity of 100 MW due to infeasibility, and iii) approve the following three proposed programs, aimed at enhancing demand management and supporting a clean energy future: 1) In-System Solar Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) Program; 2) Comprehensive Residential Energy Efficiency Rebate Program; and 3) Comprehensive Energy and Water Assessments, Installations and Concierge Services.


