

**A RESOLUTION OF THE PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE, CALIFORNIA
ESTABLISHING NEW FEES FOR THE RENTAL OF AMENITIES AT FREMONT PARK**

WHEREAS, Glendale Municipal Code Section 2.60.140 provides that reasonable fees and charges for the use of any property or facility which is under the management, care, control or supervision of the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Commission or the Director, may be established by resolution of the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Commission; and

WHEREAS, Fremont Park is under the management, care, control, or supervision of the Director of Community Services & Parks; and

WHEREAS, Fremont Park is currently undergoing refurbishment and will include a new multi-use athletic field, community building, and picnic shelters, all of which will be available for rental to the public for private use upon project completion in July 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Community Services & Parks has determined that new fees should be established for rental of the Fremont Multi-Use Field, Fremont Community Building Main Room, Fremont Community Building Meeting Room, and Fremont Picnic Shelters (per shelter); and

WHEREAS, the fees determined by the Director of Community Services & Parks for the Fremont Community Building are consistent with the existing rental rates for the Griffith Manor Community Building Main Room and Dunsmore Community Building Small Room; and

WHEREAS, the fees determined by the Director of Community Services & Parks for the Fremont Picnic Shelters are consistent with the existing rental rates for similar shelters at Lower Scholl Canyon, Deukmejian Wilderness Park, Casa Adobe de San Rafael; and

WHEREAS, the fees determined by the Director of Community Services & Parks for the Fremont Multi-Use Field are consistent with the existing rental rates for Pacific Park & Community Center's multi-use field; and

WHEREAS, the fees determined by the Director of Community Services & Parks for the rental of amenities at Fremont Park are reasonable and comparable to those charged by other cities for "like" facilities and services; and

WHEREAS, the fees for the rental of amenities at Fremont Park are eligible for the existing Approved Youth Group Discounts, Commercial Rate, Non-Profit Discount, and Sports Non-Profit Discount.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Commission of the City of Glendale that:

SECTION 1. The following Community Services & Parks fees for the rental of amenities at Fremont Park are adopted and added to the CSP Department Wide Fee Schedule:

Fee	Proposed Fee
Fremont Multi-Use Field - Weekday Rates (Mon-Fri before 6 PM)	\$61 Per Hour
Fremont Multi-Use Field - Nights & Weekend Rates (Weekday 6 PM - 10 PM and Sat & Sun)	\$92 Per Hour

Fremont Community Building - Main Room	\$60 Per Hour
Fremont Community Building - Meeting Room	\$40 Per Hour
Fremont Picnic Shelter (Per Shelter)	\$40 Per Hour

SECTION 2. The Parks, Recreation and Community Services Commission recommends that the Council of the City of Glendale incorporate into the “Comprehensive Citywide Fee Schedule” the changes made to the CSP Department Wide Fee Schedule related to Fremont Park.

SECTION 3. This Resolution takes effect on May 21, 2025.
