**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE
ESTABLISHING A CHARTER REVIEW COMMITTEE 2024**

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Council that the present Charter of the City of Glendale may need revisions so as to bring it up to date with the current law, practice and needs of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that a committee composed of citizens and city staff is the most expedient procedure to follow to study whether certain Charter amendments would be advisable.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE, CALIFORNIA:

SECTION 1. That a Charter Review Committee of the City of Glendale, 2024 be and is hereby established;

SECTION 2. That said Committee be composed of nine members to be nominated and appointed by the members of the City Council and each member appointed to said Committee be a qualified elector of the City at the time of his/her appointment and during his/her incumbency;

SECTION 3. That the City Clerk is directed to post a notice of availability of positions open for appointment on said committee;

SECTION 4. That the Committee prioritize the review of city council districts, with an expanded council size, directly elected mayor and council compensation and provide a report and recommendation in ample time for placement on the November 2024 ballot;

SECTION 5. That the Committee prioritize the review of the civil service system and provide a report and recommendation in ample time for placement on the November 2024 ballot;
