

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE, CALIFORNIA, PROVIDING
WORKERS' COMPENSATION COVERAGE FOR SPECIFIED CITY VOLUNTEERS AND
REPEALING PRIOR RESOLUTION NO. 22,080**

WHEREAS, the City of Glendale recognizes the important and ongoing contributions which are made by its many volunteers working in various divisions of the City; and,

WHEREAS, the Glendale City Council adopted Resolution No. 22,080 on June 26, 1990, pertaining to workers' compensation coverage for City volunteers; and

WHEREAS, the number of City volunteers continues to increase each year; and

WHEREAS, under California law, volunteers are not deemed employees of the City of Glendale for purposes of workers' compensation insurance coverage, or benefits thereunder; and

WHEREAS, under California Labor Code Section 3363.5, designated and authorized volunteers are deemed employees of the City for such purposes, upon adoption of a resolution by the governing body so declaring; and

WHEREAS, the City of Glendale desires to provide workers' compensation coverage for volunteers, while they are engaged in volunteer activities authorized by and for the City, provided that they meet all of the requirements set forth in this resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE:

SECTION 1. Resolution No. 22,080 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. Volunteers working for the City of Glendale shall be deemed employees of the City, for purposes of workers' compensation insurance coverage, provided such volunteers satisfy all of the following conditions:

a) such volunteers are registered with the City of Glendale Volunteer Program;

b) the primary purpose of such volunteer activity, as determined by the City Manager, or his designee, is to bestow a benefit upon the City of Glendale; and


c) such volunteers do not belong to a group, organization or association that engages in volunteer activities on a regular or periodic basis and which routinely provides its own group or individual policies of insurance while its members are engaged in such volunteer activities.

Section 3. This resolution is adopted pursuant to California Labor Code Section 3363.5.




