**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE, CALIFORNIA,
DECLARING APPROXIMATELY 19 EXPIRED POLICE BALLISTIC PROTECTION
VESTS AS OBSOLETE AND SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THEIR
DONATION TO THE CITY OF MONTEBELLO**

WHEREAS, the City of Glendale has received a request from the City of Montebello, California for police ballistic protective vests that are no longer used or needed by the Glendale Police Department;

WHEREAS, the Glendale Police Department has determined that it has approximately 19 expired police ballistic protective vests that are no longer needed;

WHEREAS, these particular police ballistic protective vests are considered expired because manufacturers of ballistic vests will not generally warrant them beyond 5 years;

WHEREAS, as with many kinds of specialized equipment, these particular vests have been used over the last approximately 16 to 20 years and thus have been subjected to normal wear and tear;

WHEREAS, these particular police ballistic protective vests are obsolete and surplus property as they are no longer used by the Glendale Police Department;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Glendale Municipal Code section 4.68.030, the City Manager is authorized to sell or exchange personal property of the City having salvage value which is obsolete or no longer useful; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to donate the expired vests to the City of Montebello, California.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE, CALIFORNIA DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council declares approximately 19 expired police ballistic protective vests to be obsolete and surplus property pursuant to Glendale Municipal Code

section 4.68.030.

SECTION 2. The City Council does hereby authorize the Interim City Manager to donate the approximately 19 police ballistic protective vests to the City of Montebello, California. Said donation shall be subject to "AS IS" conditions with no warranties of any kind as well as a waiver of liability. The City of Montebello shall take possession of the vests within 30 days of the effective date of this resolution. The Interim City Manager, or his designee, shall and is hereby directed to take any and all actions necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution.

SECTION 3. If, for any reason, the City of Montebello fails to take possession of the approximately 19 expired police ballistic protective vests within 30 days of the effective date of this resolution, then this resolution shall be null and void, and the ownership rights to the expired vests shall revert back to the City of Glendale.
