Glendale City Charter - Article VI, Section 5(4)

The council shall... Choose one (1) of its members as presiding officer, to be called mayor. The mayor shall preside over the sessions of the council, shall sign official documents when the signature of the council or mayor is required by law, and he shall act as the official head of the city on public and ceremonial occasions. He shall have power to administer oaths and affirmations. When the mayor is absent from any meeting of the council, the mayor pro tem shall be selected monthly by alphabetical rotation. The mayor pro tem shall act as mayor if the mayor is absent or unavailable.

Glendale Municipal Code – Section 2.04.020 – Selection of Mayor

Pursuant to Article VI, section 5(4) of the Charter, the council shall annually select one of its members to be the mayor. The times for appointment shall be the second Monday of April in each year in which a general municipal election is held; and in other years such selection shall be made at the regular meeting of council following the first Monday of April. In the selection of the mayor, preference is to be given members of council who have had the benefit of experience as council members prior to the time of selection. The mayor shall serve as presiding officer and perform the other duties of mayor at the pleasure of the council. (Ord. 5162 § 1, 1997: prior code § 2-3.1)
