2. Please list any educational, vocational, personal experiences and/or community participation which you feel will aid you in serving on the Glendale Housing Authority.


I have an AS Degree in Social Behavior from L.A. City College and currently I am studying part as a paralegal. I could be most useful for legal aspects as a Commissioner.
