## Statement of Interest and Purpose - Henri Gang

With Senate Bill (SB) 1383 enforcement going into effect on January 1, 2022, it is crucial that Glendale properly addresses the requirements, educates its citizens, and efficiently implements enforcement strategies. As a Student Member, one of my priorities will be to push for citizen education and community outreach for SB 1383. This can be through a myriad of ways: expanding the usage of software technologies such as Recyclist (especially with local grocery stores and restaurants), cooperate with the County through programs such as the Los Angeles County Food Drop program to reduce organic waste and donate edible foods, and advocate for incentives for unincorporated County of Los Angeles businesses to donate edible food waste to nonprofits located anywhere throughout the County.

Diverting organic waste from landfills is a critical aspect of sustainability within the City, as less waste in landfills saves landfill space and lowers methane emissions emitted by organic waste in landfills. Additionally, the push to divert organic waste alleviates food insecurity as the food waste that is still edible will go to food banks, soup kitchens, and other food recovery organizations and services rather than landfills to ensure that more people will have food to eat and stave off hunger.

In preparation for SB 1383, the Commission must readily ensure that current waste collection contracts for residents are modified to include organic waste collection and may be built to expand the procedures that are affected by Assembly Bill (AB) 1826. On top of all of this, I will ensure that the City Council is advised on the different conversion technologies that may most benefit our city. I will recommend procedures for the procurement of recovered waste products in the form of compost, mulch, and renewable energy.

An indispensable sustainable practice is not only to recycle and reuse but to reduce the overall amount of waste itself. As a member of the Commission, I hope to push the City Council to approve an ordinance for restaurants and businesses to reduce single-use plastics and withhold them unless expressly asked for. Furthermore, a push for approval of an ordinance for markets and grocery stores to place older items in front of newer items will decrease the amount of food that gets thrown away, reducing the overall amount of organic waste that is generated. Alongside City ordinance, community outreach is another useful method in reducing waste. Public Service Announcements (PSAs) through radio stations and local news networks, especially during holidays, will bring attention to the wastefulness that the holidays tend to bring, and attempt to educate citizens to curb the copious amounts of waste. PSAs can also help to reduce the amounts of household hazardous waste by informing citizens of the less commonly known types of hazardous waste such as shampoo, conditioner, and makeup so that people are influenced to buy fewer amounts of these products.

I have a great many other ideas to make Glendale even more sustainable and environmentally conscious. I hope that I will be given the opportunity to elucidate more upon this and any further contributions in an interview. Thank you for your time.
