SEPT
10th

- Last Day for each house to pass bills

OCT
10th

- Last Day for Governor to Sign or Veto Bills

JAN
1st

- Statutes take effect

JAN
3rd

- Legislature Reconvenes



UTILITY ARREARAGES FUNDING

❖ COVID-19 UTILITY BILL ARREARAGES TRAILER BILLS:

AB 148 (water) and **AB 135** (energy):

- AB 148 – Funding for past due water & wastewater - \$998.5 Million
 - California Water and Wastewater Arrearage Payment Program (CWWAPP)
- AB 135 – Funding for past due electric and gas utility bills - \$1 Billion
 - California Arrearage Payment Program (CAPP)
 - \$300 Million for POUs

AB 525 (Chiu)	Energy: offshore wind generation	CEC study on Offshore wind generation. Set a goal of at least 10,000 MW installed by 2040.	Signed into LAW
SB 733 (Hueso)	Energy storage: pumped storage hydroelectric generation facilities	Pumped storage: CPUC adopting appropriate targets.	2 Year Bill
AB 641 (Holden)	Transportation electrification	Establishing an transportation electrification plan.	2 Year Bill



KEY WATER BILLS

BILL #	TITLE	SUMMARY	STATUS
AB 652 (Friedman)	Product safety: juvenile products.	Prohibits the sale of juvenile products that contains perfluoroalkyl (PFAS) substances.	On Governor's Desk
SB 222 (Dodd)	Water Affordability Assistance Program	Water Affordability Assistance Program for low-income ratepayers experiencing economic hardship.	2 Year Bill
