A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE, CALIFORNIA, DISPENSING WITH FURTHER COMPETITIVE BIDDING, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT NO. 8000616 WITH ARB, INC. TO PROVIDE AS NEEDED MECHANICAL AND FIELD SERVICES FOR THE GRAYSON POWER PLANT AND OTHER GWP FACILITIES FOR AN ADDITIONAL TERM OF TWO YEARS AND INCREASE THE NOT TO EXCEED CONTRACT AMOUNT BY \$250,000

WHEREAS, in 2019, following a competitive bid process, the City Council awarded Contract No. 8000616, a three-year contract, to the sole bidder, ARB, Inc, (“ARB”), to furnish labor, equipment, and materials for specialized mechanical and field services for the Grayson Power Plant and Scholl Canyon Landfill Gas Plant per Specification No. 3804 (the “Contract”); and

WHEREAS, since the execution of the Contract, ARB has provided essential services to support the availability of the generating units at the Grayson Power Plant, as well as services for the Scholl Canyon Landfill Gas Pipeline Purge and Closure; and

WHEREAS, the contract term will expire on September 10, 2022, which is expected to coincide with the 2022 summer peak demand, and continued mechanical and field services are needed to keep all generating units operational until the Grayson Repowering Project is underway; and thereafter, services will be needed to maintain Grayson Unit 9, which will provide a critical supply of power during the repowering; and

WHEREAS, there is insufficient time to undertake a bidding process, award and execute contracts, and mobilize a new contractor in time to complete necessary repair work to keep the Grayson generation units functional during the 2022 summer peak period; and

WHEREAS, the work is highly specialized and very few companies are qualified to do the work, which requires familiarity with both older and newer power plant units, and ARB has a large base of direct-hire craft with specialized expertise in their field, which has proven valuable for the Grayson Power Plant repairs; and

WHEREAS, Glendale Charter Art. VI, Sec. 9 provides an exemption to competitive bidding where the Council determines it is the best interest of the City; and

WHEREAS, it is in the City's best interest, upon recommendation of the City Manager and General Manager of GWP, to dispense with further competitive bidding, and authorize the City Manager to execute an amendment to the Contract to extend the term for two years and increase the not-to-exceed amount of the Contract by \$250,000.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE:

1. That the foregoing facts are deemed to be true and correct and a basis for dispensing with further competitive bidding, and authorizing the City Manager to execute an amendment to extend Contract No. 8000616 for two years and to increase the not-to-exceed contract amount by \$250,000 to provide continued as needed mechanical and field services for the Grayson Power Plant and other GWP facilities.

2. The Council hereby dispenses with further competitive bidding and authorizes the City Manager to enter into and execute amendment extending Contract No. 8000616 for a term of two years and increasing the not to exceed amount of the

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Contract by \$250,000, for a total not to exceed Contract amount of \$1,050,000. The form of said Amendment shall be subject to the approval of the City Attorney.
