

## **MOTION**

Moved by Commissioner Vidor, seconded by Commissioner Tufenkian, that the Arts and Culture Commission hereby recommends that the City Council approve the acceptance and installation of the proposed monument by the Consulate General of Armenia in recognition of the Armenian Genocide— subject to the conditions and enhancements listed below— to be located near the front of the Central Library - 222 E. Harvard St., as more fully outlined in the March 17, 2022 Report by the Library, Arts & Culture's Principal Arts & Culture Administrator.

### **Conditions and Enhancements:**

1. The proposed size of the monument's base should be minimized;
2. The monument should not have a cone and/or pointed tip at the center; and
3. The monument should have a light coming out of the center.
