**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE
APPROVING THE ENGINEER'S REPORT FOR THE CITY OF
GLENDALE'S NORTH SAN FERNANDO ROAD CORRIDOR
LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE DISTRICT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022/2023**

WHEREAS, the City Council pursuant to provisions of the *Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 (commencing with Section 22500) Part 2, Division 15 of the California Streets and Highways Code* (hereinafter referred to as the "Act") and provisions of the City of Glendale Municipal Code (hereinafter referred to as the "Municipal Code") did by previous Resolution, order the preparation of the fiscal year 2022/2023 Engineer's Report for the North San Fernando Road Corridor Landscape Maintenance District (hereinafter referred as the "District"), and

WHEREAS, said Engineer's Report was filed with the City Clerk and based on this Report the City Council did by Resolution, on June 14, 2022, declared its intention to levy and collect assessments and charges against lots and parcels of land within the Districts for the fiscal year 2022/2023, to pay the maintenance, servicing and operation of the improvements related thereto, and

WHEREAS, this City Council has examined and reviewed the Engineer's Report as presented, and hereby finds that the assessments and charges have been spread proportionately in accordance with the special benefit each property receives from the improvements, operation, maintenance and services to be performed, as set forth in said Engineer's Report or as modified by Council action and incorporated herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The above recitals are true and correct.

SECTION 2. The Engineer's Report as presented is hereby approved pursuant to *Section 22623* of the Act and provisions of the Municipal Code, and ordered to be filed in the Office of the City Clerk as a permanent record and to remain open to public inspection.

SECTION 3. Copies of this resolution shall be filed in the offices of the City Manager, Finance Director and Public Works Engineering Departments.

SECTION 4. The Mayor shall sign and the City Clerk shall attest to the adoption of this resolution.
