In an exploration of color and scale, my design for the Verdugo Park South Facility expands beyond a mural to create an experiential piece that turns the building into a vibrant sculpture in the outdoor park setting. With paint covering the building from top to bottom, the structure now exists as a fully immersive piece of art, challenging how we look at painted designs and murals. My hope with this piece is to surprise people with a bold, punch of color that serves as a pillar for community and engagement, drawing people in and evoking a sense of exciting playfulness with its vibrancy and size.

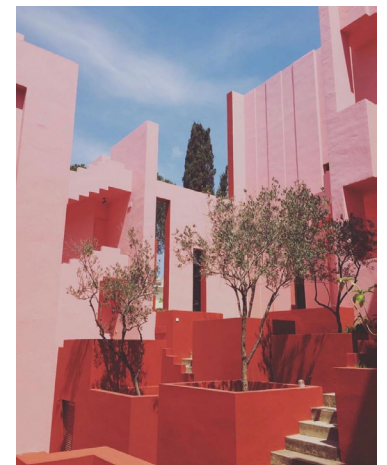
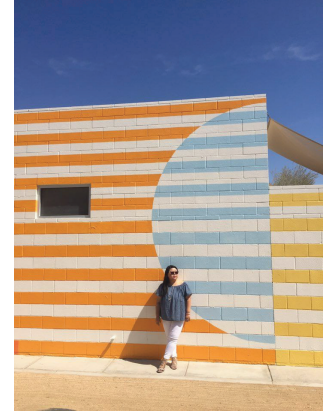
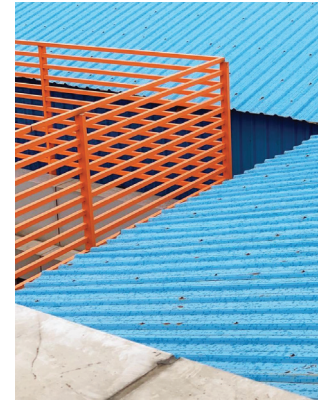

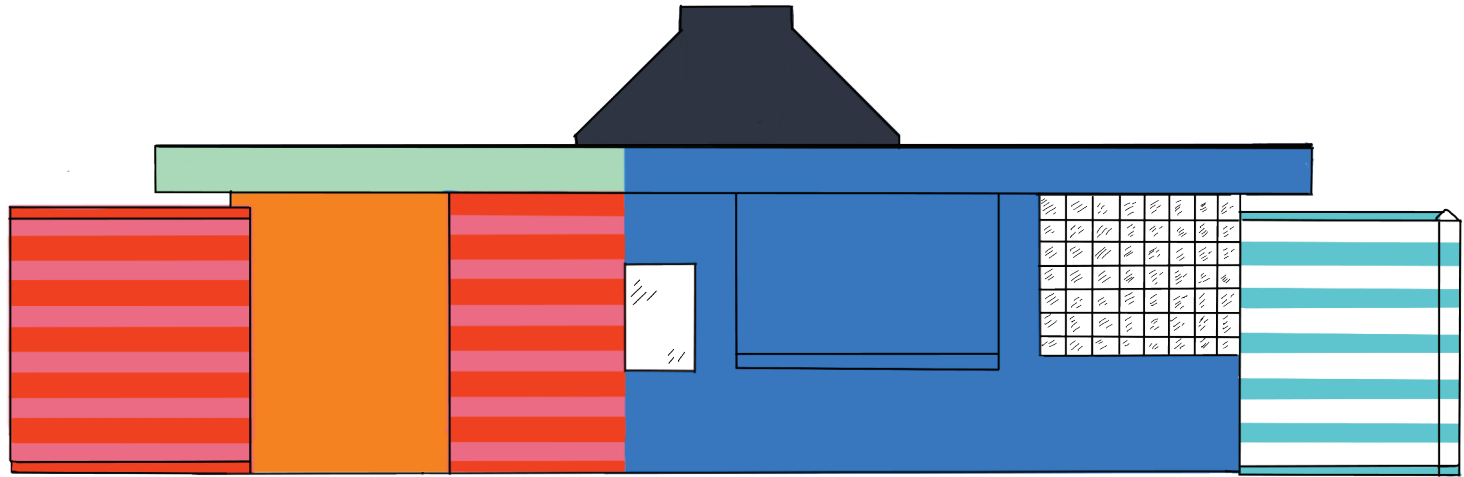

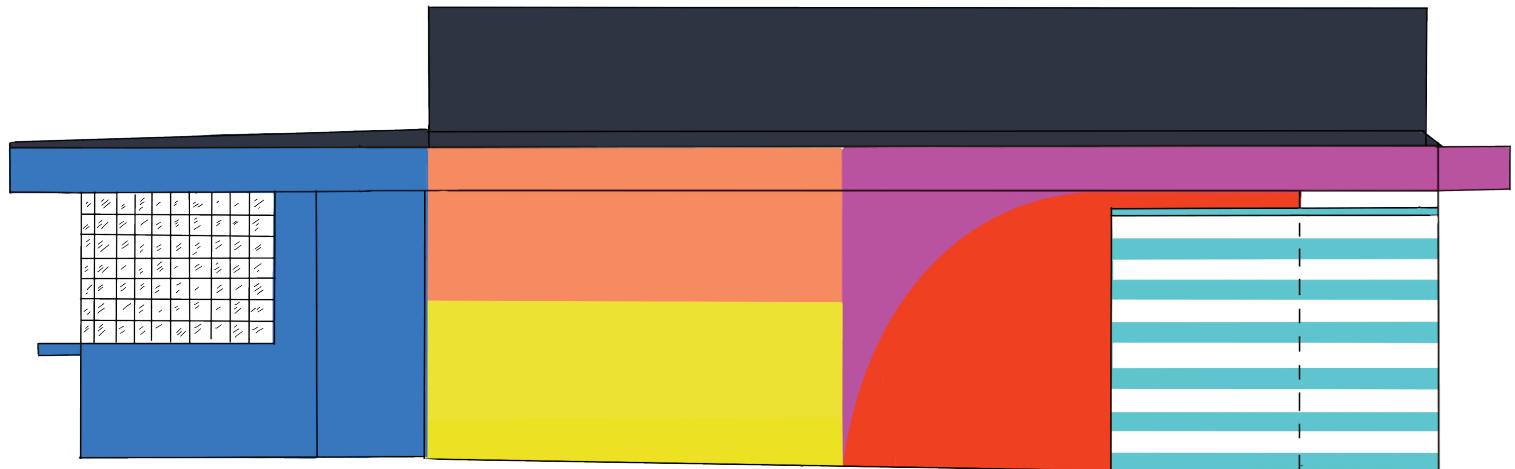

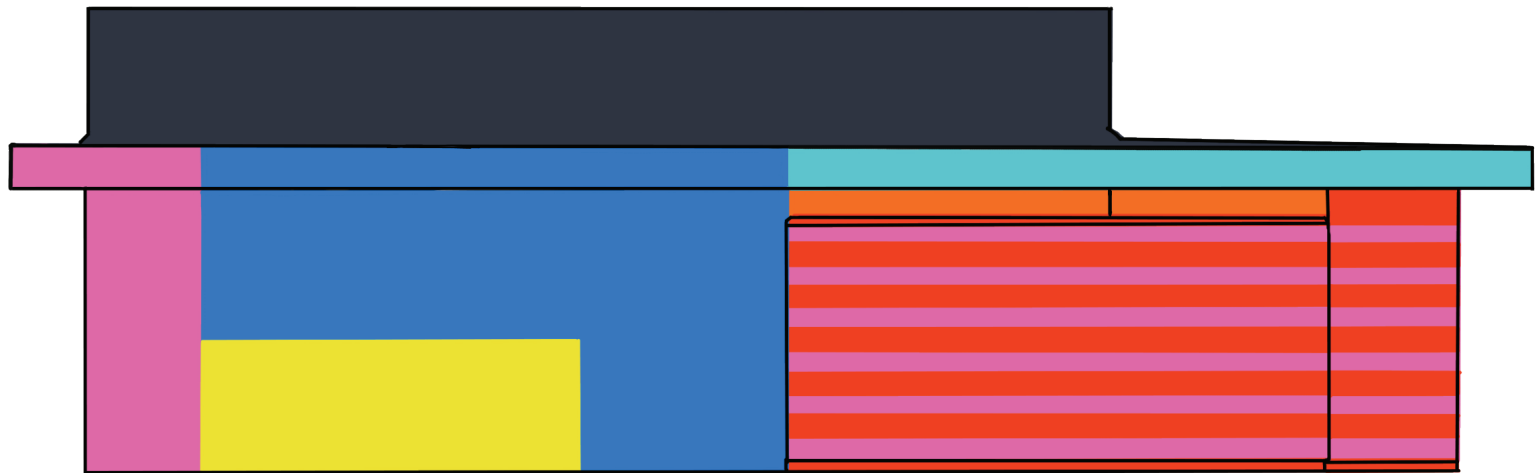

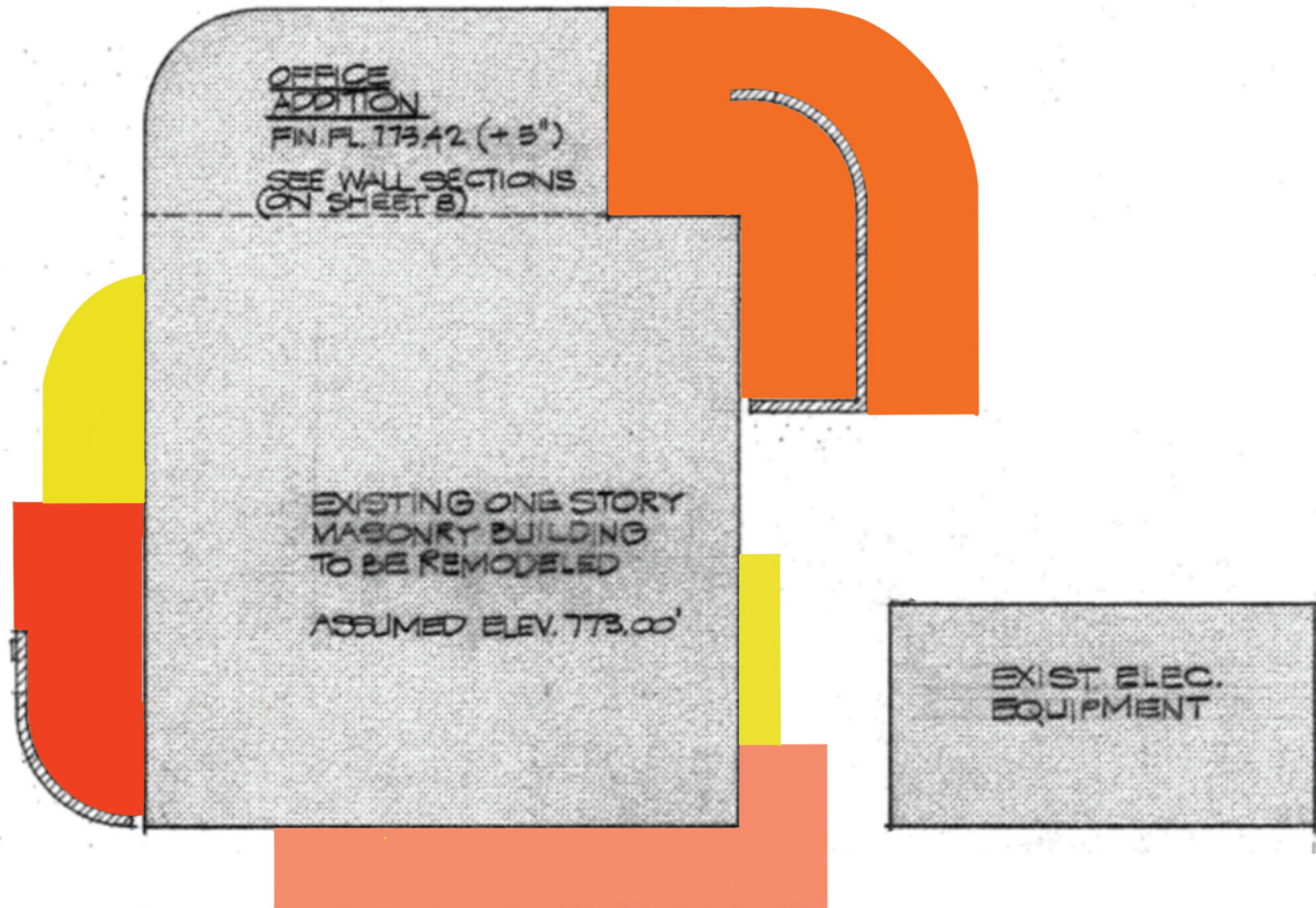

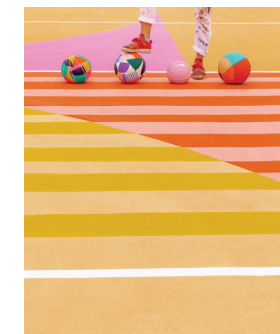
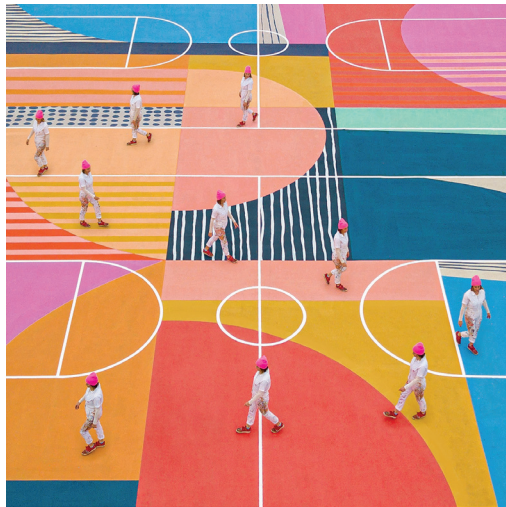
PROPOSED ADDITIONAL INSTALLATION:

BASKETBALL COURT MURAL CONCEPT

- Original mural to be designed by Erin Miller Wray if additional budget is approved
- Design will compliment mural designs of South Facility
- If budget allows, I work closely with a professional asphalt company to install the mural. We use paint made specifically for concrete and asphalt also known as "coating" - the same paint you see on roads and throughout parks and cities.
- Through this company, there is a 5 year warranty on the court artwork for any necessary restoration.

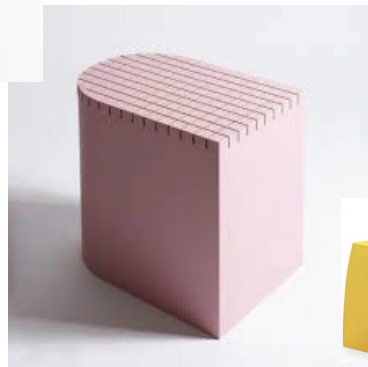

I recently visited Verdugo Park to take in the surroundings and I talked with several young adults who were playing basketball there. We chatted about how much they love coming to the park to play ball and had been doing so for years. I shared with them my dream of painting a mural on the court and was met with huge enthusiasm. I asked what they would want to see in the artwork and one of them responded, “Cover it in color! Color everywhere!” We also discussed their hope to get court lines on the ground and nets on the goals since there had not been any in years.

That is my hope for these courts – to cover them in color! I believe that through this additional mural installation we can bring more people together to inspire hope, creativity and community through art and athletics.
