**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE,  
CALIFORNIA,**

**REJECTING ALL BIDS, DISPENSING WITH COMPETITIVE BIDDING,  
AND AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS OR HIS  
DESIGNEE TO NEGOTIATE WITH ONE OR MORE BIDDERS FOR THE  
FISCAL YEAR 2023 AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA)  
CURB RAMP INSTALLATION AND SIDEWALK REPAIR PROGRAM,  
SPECIFICATION NO. 3913**

**WHEREAS**, on October 25, 2022, Council approved and adopted Specification No. 3913 for the Fiscal Year 2023 Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Curb Ramp Installation and Sidewalk Repair Program (“Project”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Public Works Department received 2 bids for the Project; and

**WHEREAS**, a detailed review of the bids revealed that both bids exceeded the estimate anticipated by the Public Works Department staff; and

**WHEREAS**, the administrative costs, staff time, and likely cost increases due to current inflation concerns mean that re-bidding the project is unlikely to realize substantial cost savings; and

**WHEREAS**, Public Works Department staff believes a collaborative negotiation with one or more of the contractors that submitted bids would allow the contractor(s) to better understand the project requirements and eliminate excessive contingencies that the contractor(s) may have included in their initial submittal; and

**WHEREAS**, it is staff’s expectation that a negotiated bid will provide further opportunities for value engineering and partnering with the contractor; both of which will reduce the overall cost and allow the City to construct the best possible improvement within the available funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the Project currently has significant momentum due to the Public Works Department staff’s efforts and in order to maintain the progress of this project and funding, staff believes it is in the City’s best interest to negotiate with one or more of the contractors that submitted responsive bids on November 16, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, Glendale City Charter, Article IV, Section 9 authorizes the City Council, after rejecting bids, to dispense with competitive bidding and to have the contract negotiated without further bidding.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE:**

1. The foregoing facts are deemed to be true and correct, and are a basis for rejecting the bids and dispensing with competitive bidding.
2. The Council hereby:
  - A. Rejects all bids for the Project;
  - B. Dispenses with competitive bidding for the Project; and
  - C. Authorizes the Director of Public Works or his designee to negotiate with one or more bidders for the Project, Specification No. 3913.
