## A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE, CALIFORNIA, DECLARING SIX (6) TASERS AND RELATED EQUIPMENT OUTDATED PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THEIR DONATION TO THE CITY OF ARVIN

WHEREAS, the City of Glendale has received a request from the City of Arvin,
California for police tasers that are no longer used or needed by the Glendale Police
Department;

WHEREAS, the Glendale Police Department has determined that it has six (6) outdated tasers that are no longer needed and related equipment as follows: six (6) Blackhawk left-handed holsters, two (2) Blackhawk right-handed holsters, two (2) nylon ambidextrous holsters, fifty (50) live cartridges, and one (1) Evidence Sync Cable;

WHEREAS, these particular police tasers are considered outdated because the Department has switched to a new model which is incompatible with the six (6) outdated tasers;

**WHEREAS**, as with many kinds of specialized equipment, these particular tasers and related equipment have been used over the years and thus have been subjected to normal wear and tear;

**WHEREAS**, these particular police tasers are outdated and surplus property as they are no longer used by the Glendale Police Department;

WHEREAS, pursuant to <u>Glendale Municipal Code</u> section 4.68.030, the City Manager is authorized to sell or exchange personal property of the City having salvage value which is obsolete or no longer useful; and

**WHEREAS,** the City Council desires to donate the outdated tasers and related equipment to the City of Arvin, California.

## NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE, CALIFORNIA DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1.** The City Council declares six (6) outdated police tasers (Serial #s: X12008A8V, X12007F13, X120063EM, X12007Y3X, X12009HWF and X12009F39) and six (6) Blackhawk left-handed holsters, two (2) Blackhawk right-handed holsters, two (2) nylon ambidextrous holsters, fifty (50) live cartridges, and one (1) Evidence Sync Cable to be outdated and surplus property pursuant to <u>Glendale Municipal Code</u> section 4.68.030.

**SECTION 2.** The City Council does hereby authorize the City Manager to donate the outdated tasers and related equipment to the City of Arvin, California. Said donation shall be subject to "AS IS" conditions with no warranties of any kind as well as a waiver of liability. The City of Arvin shall take possession of the vests within 30 days of the effective date of this resolution. The City Manager, or his designee, shall and is hereby directed to take any and all actions necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution.

**SECTION 3.** If, for any reason, the City of Arvin fails to take possession of the six (6) police tasers and related equipment within 30 days of the effective date of this resolution, then this resolution shall be null and void, and the ownership rights to the expired vests shall revert back to the City of Glendale.
