**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE, CALIFORNIA,
DECLARING THE EXISTING KITCHEN EQUIPMENT AS SURPLUS PROPERTY AND
HAVING SALVAGE VALUE AND AUTHORIZING THEIR DONATION TO
THE FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH OF GLENDALE**

WHEREAS, the existing kitchen equipment at Adult Recreation Center, which is thirteen years old, has remained in service and is overdue for replacement;

WHEREAS, Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) Nutrition Infrastructure (NI) grant funding will be used to replace the existing kitchen equipment at Adult Recreation Center;

WHEREAS, the existing kitchen equipment, having salvage value, normally would be removed and legally disposed of as surplus equipment;

WHEREAS, on June 15, 2023, the First Baptist Church of Glendale— a non-profit organization founded in 1909 to address social issues regarding homelessness and hunger facing residents in Glendale— contacted City staff and requested the kitchen equipment for use at its kitchen facility;

WHEREAS, the City will incur no costs for shipping the equipment, because First Baptist Church of Glendale, will pay for the transfer;

WHEREAS, the City's donation of the kitchen equipment to the First Baptist Church of Glendale will enable the City to dispose of surplus equipment, without the City's incurring (1) the time or administrative expense of an auction, and (2) the kitchen equipment's normal dump fee at a landfill; and

WHEREAS, the City Council and City Manager are authorized under Subsection 9, Section 2 of Article III of Glendale's Charter and Section 4.68.030 of the Glendale Municipal Code, 1995, to dispose of surplus personal property and to promote the general welfare of the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby finds that the property described above in this Resolution is surplus personal property which has little, if any, extrinsic value, and therefore, should not be subject to sale at auction.

SECTION 2. The Director of Community Services and Parks is hereby authorized to donate (transfer) the personal property to the First Baptist Church of Glendale.
