RECOMMENDATION

It is respectfully recommended that the City Council authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to execute an amendment to the agreement with EdgeSoft, Inc. to acquire one year of annual software maintenance, services, support and licensing for the City's license and permitting system in the amount of \$197,000 and subsequent amendments as necessary and approved by the City Council in the annual citywide budget process.

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

In 2007, the City implemented a Land Management System (LMS), known as City Services Interface (CSI), to help track and manage all of the City's land use activities. Common functions of the Land Management System include but are not limited to plan check, permitting, licensing, inspections, and code enforcement. Since 2007, EdgeSoft has provided maintenance services, however, the system has reached its end-of-life. As a result, we will be replacing the system with EnerGov which is a new Land Management System and has the additional functionality that staff and residents have been requesting.

The City commenced implementation of EnerGov earlier this year and is scheduled to go live in the spring of 2022. During the implementation to the post go-live phase, and through and including completion, the City will need to continue to receive fixes, services and support from EdgeSoft for the legacy system to ensure there are no business interruptions and making sure the transition is seamless. Though not anticipated, the City may require additional time to extend the EdgeSoft Services beyond FY 21/22, in which case staff will budget for such funds through the annual budget process and present to City Council for approval.

FISCAL IMPACT

The total estimated cost for EdgeSoft software maintenance, services, support and licensing for one year is \$197,000 which has been budgeted in the FY 21/22 Applications Fund Budget, Contractual Services Account, 43110-6040-ISD-5502-P0000-T0000-F0000. Funds for the remaining services of EdgeSoft for the post go-live phase of the EnerGov implementation will be budgeted within ISD FY22/23 Applications Fund and approved by the City Council as part of the annual citywide budget process.

ALTERNATIVES

Alternative 1: The City Council may authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to execute an amendment to the agreement with EdgeSoft, Inc. to extend the term by one year of annual software maintenance, services, support and licensing for the City's license and permitting system in the amount of \$197,000 and subsequent amendments as necessary and approved by the City Council in the annual citywide budget process.

Alternative 2: The City Council may not approve the contract amendment with EdgeSoft, Inc. to extend the term by one year for the annual software maintenance, services, support and licensing for the City's license and permitting system. In this case the system would be unsupported and the City may not be able to restore it without

vendor support, which would disrupt the license and permitting services provided to staff and residents.

Alternative 3: The City Council may consider any other alternative not proposed by staff.
