Report: Award of Professional Services Agreements (PSAs) with Two Qualified Laboratories, **Weck Laboratories, Inc.** and **Eurofins Eaton Analytical, LLC** for Laboratory Services for Water Quality Analysis and Reporting.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Glendale Water and Power (GWP) staff recently completed a Request for Proposal (RFP) process with accredited laboratories to perform laboratory services for a threeyear period. Staff is seeking approval to award Professional Services Agreements to two laboratories for a not-to-exceed amount of \$200,000 per laboratory.

COUNCIL PRIORITIES

<u>Infrastructure</u>: The Water Division of GWP has the responsibility to protect the health of Glendale's residents, workers, and visitors from pathogenic organisms and chronic illnesses that could be caused by ingesting or using contaminated drinking water. Utilizing qualified laboratories to test and analyze water samples is a critical part of protecting public health within the City.

RECOMMENDATION

Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to execute two (2) three-year Professional Services Agreements (PSAs) with two qualified laboratories, Weck Laboratories, Inc. and Eurofins Eaton Analytical, LLC, to provide analytical laboratory services for drinking water and environmental compliance for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$200,000 per laboratory.

BACKGROUND

GWP, in compliance with its domestic water supply permit under federal and state drinking water regulations, monitors the water quality at the City's treatment, storage, and distribution system facilities. GWP staff collects the samples that are sent for analysis to an outside laboratory certified by the State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Drinking Water (DDW). Currently, GWP has a PSA with Eurofins Eaton Analytical, to provide this analytical work, which expires December 31, 2022.

In preparation for expiration of the existing PSA, GWP staff solicited proposals from four qualified laboratories on October 10, 2022.

Babcock Laboratories, Inc. Eurofins Eaton Analytical, LLC Pace Analytical Services, LLC (formerly BC Laboratories, Inc.) Weck Laboratories, Inc.

Three qualified laboratories submitted proposals as follows:

Pacelabs Weck Laboratories Eurofins Eaton Analytical

The proposals were evaluated based on their pricing, professional, and practical qualifications, location, experience, and quality control programs. To help evaluate the proposals, the properser were asked to provide pricing on nearly 26,000 tests of 142 different chemicals with an estimated 11,000 tests per year for the City of Glendale.

ANALYSIS

The proposals were evaluated by representatives of GWP's Water Quality Section. The following criteria were used in the evaluation of proposals:

- The laboratory's qualifications based on the comprehensiveness of the overall bid package in addressing the testing requirements.
- The laboratory's qualifications based on the overall lab facility and instrumentation, professional and practical experience, and the nature of its Quality Control Program.
- The completeness of the proposals.
- The prices and standard turnaround times, including the evaluation of cost increases for rush turnaround times, to perform the analyses under this PSA.

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required short holding times due to their more distant location in Bakersfield. This lowered Pace's overall ranking, and shows that Weck and Eurofins' costs are lower when subtracting these items from their proposals.

Staff are recommending award to two laboratories in order to provide flexibility when sending samples out for testing for unforeseen reasons such as one laboratory being backlogged, or in the event of one of the laboratories experiencing issues with their lab or computer system, in which case the City can utilize the services of the other laboratory.
